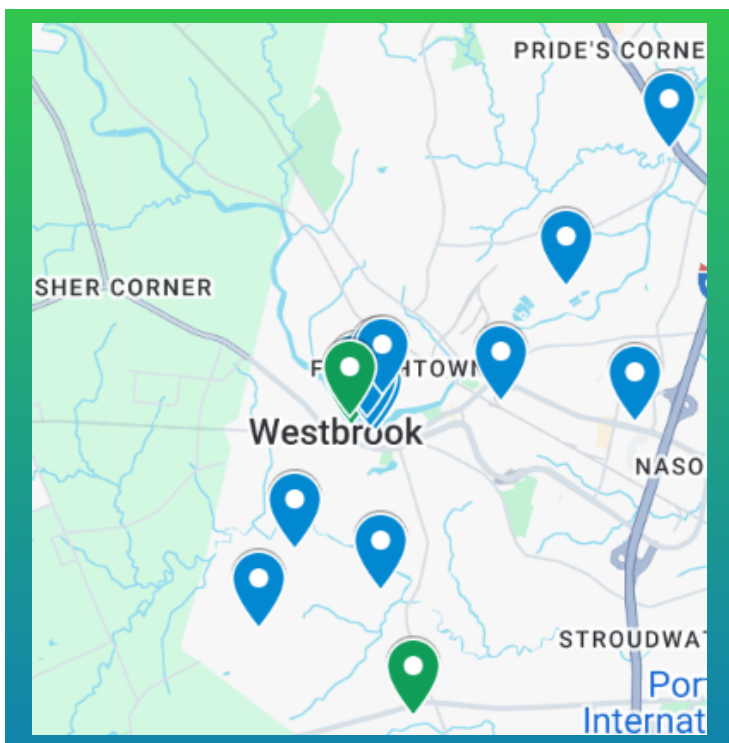

Community Description

Westbrook is a riverside community of 21,386 (2024 estimate) located along the Presumpscot River in Cumberland County, Maine, and is part of the Greater Portland metropolitan area. The city covers 17.3 mi² and was incorporated in 1891, named after Colonel Thomas Westbrook. Historically, Westbrook developed as a mill town, with paper and textile industries driving its growth throughout the 19th and 20th centuries. The city has access to both rural and urban amenities. While manufacturing shaped much of the city's identity, Westbrook has since transitioned into a diverse community with historic charm and a focus on modern economic development, community revitalization, and a growing arts and cultural scene.
